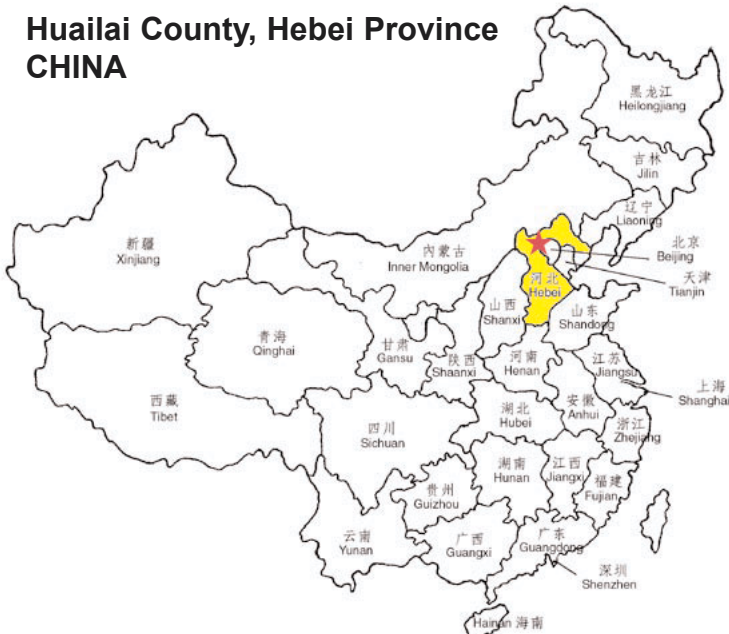

### Huailai County, Hebei Province CHINA



The Dragon Seal vineyard is located 95 miles NW of Beijing (latitude: N 40°16', longitude: E 115°45') and ranges in altitude between 1600–2000 feet above sea level. The vineyard's hillside location and sandy soil limit its yield naturally, thus giving rise to high quality grapes and great wines.

Summer high temperatures at the vineyard generally range between 85°F and 90°F, with lows around 70°F. Long cool nights during September and early-October support a slow ripening process.

Winter temperatures can dip down to 0°F during the months of January and February. Therefore, between November and April, the vines are covered with 15 inches of dirt to prevent frost damage.
