

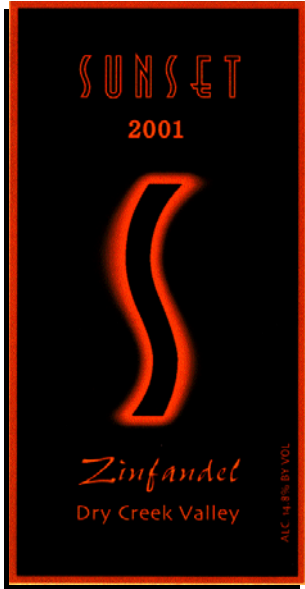

Dry Creek Valley

Winemaking Notes: Two blocks from the J Teldeschi Ranch provided the grapes for this wine. One was planted in 1960 and the other is believed to have been planted in 1912.

Intense violet and berry aromas, layered flavors of raspberry and black-berry fruit and spice, mixed with some earthy, peppery undercurrents. The finish is long, fruity and subtly tannic. This bold yet elegant wine is delicious now, but will reward additional time in the bottle.

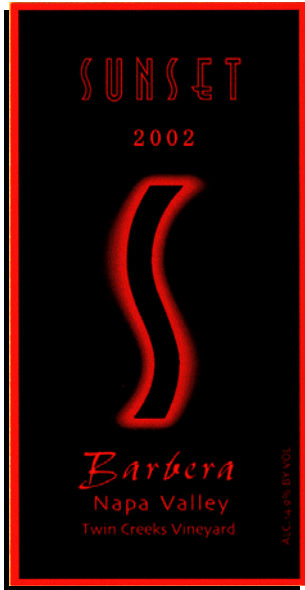

Napa Valley

Winemaking Notes: The main Barbera clone for this wine has small, loose clusters and berries, This is in contrast with much of the Barbera grown in California, which typically has much larger clusters and berries. As a result, the grapes produce deep color and concentrated flavors.

The wine balances ripe, concentrated fruit and a supple texture with the firm acidity characteristic of Barbera. Dark cherry and floral aromas lead to rich, mouth-filling plum, berry and black cherry flavors with hints of spice, and a touch of almond and chocolate.

Sunset Cellars Zinfandel 2002

Suisun Valley (Solano County), Ledgewood Vineyards

Winemaking Notes: The vinyard was picked in two lots to ensure consistent ripeness and balance. Yield was under 4 tons per acre.

Bright berry and cherry aromas, with a touch of spice. Its raspberry and blackberry flavors, soft tannins and firm acidity make it a pleasure to drink now, though hints of vanilla and pepper suggest that it will reward aging over the next few years. Long, crisp finish with hints of plum.

Composition: 99% Zinfandel, 0.5% Carignane, 0.5% Petite Sirah
